What is the Academy at the CCI?

- Charter High School Program
- Students apply through the lottery.
- Serves all 5 high schools in DCSS
- 11 teachers
- Grades 9-12
- Students can only enter the Academy during the 9th grade year through a lottery.
- Students are still considered a student of their base school, just taking classes on our campus.

The Academy School Day

- 8:45-2:45
- Transportation will be provided from each high school.
- Students are eligible to participate in extra-curricular activities at their base high school.
- Students will eat lunch at the CCI.
- Tutoring will be available before and after school as needed.

Instruction for the Academy

- All students receive a Chromebook to use for instruction.
- Class sizes will be 18-25 students.
- All courses will be taught at the college prep level.
- Students will participate in all mandated state assessments.
- Students will follow a 4x4 schedule.
- Students will take traditional academic and elective courses.
 - Currently we offer Marketing and Broadcast Video.
- Students will have the option to take Dual Enrollment elective courses beginning in 10th grade and Dual Enrollment core classes beginning in 11th grade.
- Students will graduate from their base high school.

Parent/Guardian Involvement for the Academy

- Parents/Guardians will be required to volunteer 10 hours per family per year.
- Parents/Guardians are required to attend a CCI parent meeting at the beginning of the school year.
- Examples of parent involvement hours: working with your student to ensure assignments are completed, chaperoning field trips/student activities, attending "Parent University", participating on the CCI Board or PTA/PTO, donations to the school, etc.

Eligibility for the Academy

- All 8th grade students who attend Douglas County schools are eligible to apply.
- Students will not be required to complete any test or measure in order to be admitted to the 9th grade program.
- Once students are formally enrolled, formal and informal assessments may be administered to determine the most appropriate instructional plan.

Registration for the Academy

- Enrollment period is from January 8 January 26.
- Enrollment forms should be submitted online through the link on the CCI website at (https://cci.dcssga.org/)
- Lottery will be held on January 30 @ 5pm, CCI Atrium (Building D).
- Parents/Guardians of students selected in the lottery will be expected to complete an enrollment packet and participate in the Freshmen Expo at the CCI.

Lottery for the Academy

- We will conduct a lottery drawing on **Tuesday, January 30**th **at 5:00 pm** in the atrium of the CCI. Parents are welcome to attend, but it is not mandatory.
- CCI staff will email letters of notification to parents on February 1st to inform them of their status.
- Parents: Letters of commitment must be mailed to or dropped off at the Academy at the CCI by 4:00 pm on Friday, February 9th to accept their placement-not postmarked but received by 4 pm on the 9th.
